Fees

The following fees apply to motor vehicle registration in North Dakota:

- Passenger car: \$55
- Truck: \$75
- Motorcycle: \$35
- Trailer: \$30
- Motor home: \$100

In addition to the base registration fee, you may also have to pay the following fees:

- Sales tax: 5%
- County fee: \$5
- City fee: \$5 (if applicable)
- Late fee: \$25 (if applicable)

Requirements

To register your motor vehicle in North Dakota, you will need the following:

- A completed Vehicle Registration Application (Form SFN 42961)
- Proof of ownership (such as a title or bill of sale)
- Proof of insurance
- Payment for the registration fees

To renew in person, you will need to take your license plates and registration card to your local county treasurer's office and pay the registration fees.
